Kerala Hockey is an association recognized by the Kerala Olympic Association and the Kerala State Sports Council. It is a member unit of the national hockey federation "Hockey India." This is a registered society formed to develop the game of hockey in the state. The goal of Kerala Hockey is to promote hockey in the state by connecting sports power through youth in nation-building and managing schemes and projects effectively through professional administration. As the General Secretary of Kerala Hockey, I hereby submit the report regarding the activities conducted by Kerala Hockey during the 2024-2025 period.

Meetings

During the period 2024 – 2025, the Annual General Council, the Annual General Council, a Special Council, a PST meeting, three Council meetings, and three Special Council meetings were held in the Church on June 8, 2024.

Annual General Council 2023-2024

08/06/2024 The Kerala Hockey Annual General Council meeting was held at 10.00 am at the Conference Hall of Hotel White Damer, Thiruvananthapuram under the chairmanship of the Honorable President Mr. V. 2nd Hockey India South Zone Championship 2024

The 2024 edition of the South Asian Games (Senior Women & Men) will be hosted by the Karachi Games. The tournament will be held from July 19 to 25 at the New Delhi International Stadium. The Junior Women & Men categories will feature six teams each.



In the last match of the day in the prestigious 2024 Sub Junior South Asian Games Men's category, the home team defeated the home team 8-0. Bahala Suraj (16', 44', 55') scored a hat-trick to give the home team a 1-0 lead.

The match turned out to be a success. Raju Bangaru (15+', 32') scored two goals, while Ajeev (12'), Lakshmi Aditya (38'), and Aditya K.S (59') scored one goal each. Adam Sourav emerged victorious in the men's category.

The 2024 Sub-Junior Women's South Asian Championship team has been selected. The first team is from the 1st team and the second team is from the 2nd team.

The Indian women's hockey team defeated the People's Republic of China 1-0 in the final held at the Rajgir Hockey Stadium in Bihar. Won the Asian Champions Trophy 2024. Deepika (31') scored the winning goal for the Indian women's hockey team and finished as the top scorer of the tournament with 11 goals.

This is India's third women's Asian Champions Trophy hockey title, bringing them level with the Republic of Korea as the most successful nation in the competition's history. After winning their maiden title in 2016, the Indian women also won the 2023 edition.

Fans were treated to end-to-end hockey in the first half as world number nine India and China, ranked sixth in the latest rankings, traded chances with each other. While a two-goal cushion in the third quarter would have made things easier for the home team, the Indian defence held firm in the final quarter for their fifth consecutive clean sheet of the tournament, Won a record-equaling title. Earlier, Japan defeated Malaysia 4-1 to secure third place in the 2024 Women's Asian Champions Trophy.

Kerala has a lot to improve in terms of performance in the National Championships. The Kerala Sports Council has provided 15 days of training and support for children to participate in the National Championships. The ground that used to come has not been available for the last three years. Also, Kerala has only one Astro Turf for all the districts. Therefore, there are limitations in playing on Astro Turfs for training for the National Competition and making progress. Only if at least one Astro Turf is installed in every district can the team reach the national standard. It can only be delivered. This has been brought to the attention of the government several times.

The grand inauguration ceremony was graced by Shri. Prema Chandran (MP), while the closing ceremony was graced by the Hon'ble Finance Minister and the Sports Council Secretary.

Hockey stick distribution and training

Kerala Hockey and the Kerala Government have jointly awarded the best two teams in the districts where training has been provided using hockey sticks provided by Kerala Hockey for over 3 consecutive years. 40 premium carbon hockey sticks each were provided to schools in 12 districts, namely Thiruvananthapuram, Kollam, Pathanamthitta, Alappuzha, Idukki, Ernakulam, Thrissur, Palakkad, Malappuram, Kozhikode, Kannur, and Kasaragod, which submitted applications. A total of 480 premium carbon hockey sticks were distributed.

Coupon distribution

In addition to the smooth running of Kerala Hockey and the participation of six teams in various categories in the National Hockey Tournament, the coaching camp and other expenses, the last second Kerala Hockey printed and distributed donation coupons of Rs. 50, Rs. 100 and Rs. 500 towards the expenses of the South India South Zone Sub-Junior Championship.. It was decided that 50% of the amount received by the districts would be used for the daily operations of the respective district hockey units and the remaining 50 percent would be given to Kerala Hockey. Kerala Hockey then printed coupons and sent them to each district. Kerala Hockey received the amounts given below from the districts. h) Kozhikode Hockey Unit

While evaluating the achievements and achievements of Kozhikode Hockey in the past period, we should take it as self-criticism that although we were able to go a long way from what we had in the past period, we were not able to undertake activities according to the potential.

The intervention of the State Committee has often been helpful in moving our activities forward. The President has directly called the inactive committee to the committee and has been able to resolve the shortcomings and move forward. We have been able to conduct league competitions in all categories and send all six teams. Last time, we overcame the difficulty in finding a team in the senior and junior categories in the women's category and the best team participated in the state championship. We have been able to provide hockey training in new schools and provide excellent support for the growth and activities of hockey.

Despite many shortcomings, the committee will continue to move forward in Kozhikode Hockey with good mental unity in the future. We need to be able to take the criticisms of the State Committee in a healthy way and honestly evaluate our own criticisms and move forward in a better way.

i) Wayanad Hockey Unit

Wayanad District Hockey Association has been performing well in limited circumstances. Training camps are being conducted in about 10 schools. Lack of hockey grounds is an obstacle to conducting training in more places...

Mananthavady Government College won the first place in the history of Kannur University Hockey Competition for the first time... 15 hockey players who played in the team were from the backward classes. In this, 8 players from Wayanad participated in the South Indian University Competition. One got a place in the All India University Competition. Children belonging to the tribal sections of the district are showing great interest in hockey. If they get the necessary kit and camp, they can be brought into the mainstream.

Similarly, more than 100 sportsmen are undergoing training at the Ambedkar Tribal Hospital in Neloornadu... The absence of a coach has been a problem for some time. This matter has been brought to the attention of the authorities and now they are being trained on a daily wage basis. Kochi is being assigned and regular training is being conducted... In the last school national competition, one person from this school was involved in the team...

Participated in the state competition from the district in the senior and junior categories.... The team selection was done by conducting the senior championship... The committee is working with Mr. Madhu as president and Mr. Sumit as secretary in charge. The District Hockey Association is getting the support and cooperation of Dr. Jamshad, Salim Kadavan, Mr. Nawaz, Sajid NC, Solomon, and others from Mananthavady Government College.

a) Kannur Hockey Unit

1) District Hockey League Championship is being conducted as per the instructions of Kerala Hockey. Senior Men & Women, Junior Boys – Girl, Sub Junior Boys - Girl, Championship was conducted at Pathiripad School. From that, 25 players were selected and given a camp.

2) Junior Sub Junior-Final Selection was conducted for the Senior category on March 16 and Final Selection was conducted on March 24.

District Team was formed and all the teams were given a camp at Pathiriad School.

3) Two children got selected for the Kerala team. (1) Senior Men Nishant, (2) Junior Men Musa Bin Talib.

4) The District Hockey in State Championship was held at Thalassery Stadium from 6th May 2024, under the leadership of Sub Junior Boys Kannur Hockey. The winner was Sai Kollam.

5) As part of the International Olympic Day celebrations, 25 hockey players from Hockey Kannur participated in the Olympic relay held in Kannur on 23rd June 2024 under the leadership of Idukki District Olympic Association.

6) Awareness class against drugs

j) Kasaragod Hockey Unit

The summary of the activities of Kasaragod Hockey in the year 2024-25 is attached below. Although it was not possible to undertake many activities, it is a matter of pride that through the work done, it was possible to make this initiative more popular and to support and encourage the children who have taken up the game of hockey in the district.

1. School Level Hockey Activities

Although the initial activities to popularize the game by distributing hockey sticks in about thirty schools have been done, the fact that Kasaragod Hockey is unable to provide the necessary coaches continues to be a limitation. Therefore, the fact that the desired growth has not been achieved in other schools except for about twelve schools remains a drawback. Kasaragod Hockey has not been able to achieve the necessary financial security to provide it. However, in schools like Rajapuram, Varakkad, Kanhangad South, Thrikaripur, Thrikaripur South, where training is going on well, not only have we been able to develop good quality teams in all categories, but it is also a proud achievement that the district has been able to become the runner-up in this year's state-level school junior girls category. I congratulate the parents, teachers and coaches who cooperated in all kinds of activities and training in the said schools. However, the lack of goalkeeper kits remains a drawback for the progress of the said schools.

2. Olympic Day Celebration Program

This year's Olympic Day celebration was held in a grand program on 23.06.2024 in Kanhangad with the joint support of all sports organizations including hockey. The Olympic Games started with a procession of state, national and international athletes, children and organizers from Kanhangad town to Kanhangad South and the new bus stand. The meeting place at the new bus stand was inaugurated by MLA Shri. E. Chandrasekharan. Prominent sports figures and the Kanhangad Municipal Chairperson welcomed the meeting.

3. District Championship, Team Selection & Training

The District Championship and Team Selection for the sub-junior boys, girls and junior boys categories were held at the Rajapuram Holy Family High School Ground on May 2 and 3, 2025. Although the participation and performance of the children were excellent, the huge cost of such a championship remains an obstacle.

4. Senior Boys Selection Camp

The selection camp of the district team participating in the Stage Championship to be held in Kollam in the last week of March 2025 was held at the Nileshwaram Municipal Stadium on 16.03.25. Only 8 players reached the camp. Therefore, although we were not interested in sending a team that was poorly trained and poorly prepared to participate in the championship, we submitted to the insistence of the players who arrived there and sent the team on their responsibility. However, not only did we suffer a miserable defeat, but also a team member named Shamjith suffered a serious injury to his nose during the match and was hospitalized. As soon as we got to know about it, we donated 3500/- towards the hospital expenses.


This year, the highest number of match officials from Kerala participated in the Hockey India National Championships. This is considered a proud achievement.

For the last three years, Kerala sports organizations have been facing financial difficulties due to non-receipt of the grant given by the Sports Council from the Kerala government to train children and to participate the Kerala team in national competitions. In addition, Kerala Hockey has had to face many cases in the last four years. We do not have any evidence that all the individuals who filed these cases have personally done anything for the betterment of Kerala Hockey during the period they were leading or after that. The case is still ongoing in the High Court. More than 5 lawyers are appearing for this case. Those who have filed the case have sometimes been able to influence the government by giving false information and conducting investigations against Kerala Hockey and taking temporary measures. Due to this, it has been difficult for hockey players from

Kerala to get grace marks. So far, we have received verdicts that have accepted our honesty in the cases that have been held in the courts. Also, the Sports Council now allows us to hold championships only if we pay money in advance. It was not like that before.

Hockey India has played a crucial role in providing sound advice and steadfast support in our case management and in the activities of Kerala Hockey. On this occasion, I would like to express my special gratitude to Hockey India. Today, Hockey India is doing the best work in India.

On this journey, Kerala Hockey expresses its heartfelt gratitude to Hockey India for its full support in promoting the sport of hockey in the state.





<p>Note - 1 Brief about the entity:</p> <p>The entity is a recognized body to manage, control, and administer the game of Hockey in the state of kerala and it is recognized by Kerala State Sports Council. Kerala Hockey is the member unit of 'Hockey India', the National Hockey Federation. It is a registered society in the State formed to develop the Game of Hockey. It came into existence on 24th August 2014. Kerala State Sports Council recognized Kerala Hockey as its affiliated member from 21st July 2017.</p>
<p>Note - 2 Significant Accounting Policies: Society is a going concern following accrual method of accounting.</p> <p>2.1 Basis of Accounting The financial statements have been prepared on the historical cost convention and on the accrual basis of accounting unless otherwise stated, in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles in India.</p> <p>2.2 Use of Estimates The preparation of financial statements requires the Management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities, disclosure of contingent liabilities as of the date of the financial statements, and the reported amounts of income and expenses for the year. Actual results could differ from those estimates.</p> <p>2.3 Revenue Recognition a. Admission fee, Sponsorship fee, Participation fee and other income are recognized on an accrual basis. b. Grant is recognized when the right to receive is established.</p> <p>2.4 Fixed Assets Fixed Assets are stated at historical cost less accumulated depreciation. Cost includes all expenses incurred to bring the asset to its present location and condition.</p> <p>2.5 Depreciation Depreciation is provided on a written down value (WDV) method at the rates prescribed under the Income Tax Act, 1961, unless otherwise stated. Depreciation is charged on a pro-rata basis for additions or deletions made during the year.</p> <p>2.6 Impairment of Assets The carrying amounts of assets are reviewed at each balance sheet date to determine whether there is any indication of impairment. An impairment loss is recognized wherever the carrying amount of an asset exceeds its recoverable amount.</p> <p>2.7 Investments Investments, if any, are carried at cost. Provision for diminution in the value of long-term investments is made only if such a decline is other than temporary.</p> <p>2.8 Employee Benefits Salaries, wages, and other benefits are accounted for on an accrual basis. The Association does not operate any retirement benefit plan unless mandated by statute.</p> <p>2.9 Provisions and Contingent Liabilities Provisions are recognized when there is a present obligation as a result of past events and it is probable that an outflow of resources will be required to settle the obligation. Contingent liabilities are disclosed by way of notes and are not recognized in the books.</p> <p>2.10 Income Tax The entity being an AOP recognises tax on accrual basis, if applicable.</p>
